At its core, it is about promoting "active citizens" in the sense of "active aging" and their quality of life - a cultural and social concern that governments have to take care of. The paper was sent to the Slovenian government and to the EU Commission.

## Ad Al 4:

Prof. Kellermann presents the history, the objectives, the successes and challenges of the "Seniorstudium Liberale<sup>2</sup>", which has been offered at the University of Klagenfurt for more than 10 years in cooperation with other post-secondary educational institutions in Carinthia.

## Ad AI 5:

Prof. Natale Gaspare De Santo informs about the aims and the role of the European Association of Professors Emeriti by means of a set of slides. He refers in particular to a number of important publications concerning the "Human Capital of Age", and to the first congress of the Association, which took place in Athens in 2019. A key objective is to counteract discrimination against old age and old people.

#### Ad Al 6:

Prof. Dr. Jože Gričar briefly explains the intention and content of the paper, which calls on the Slovenian government to establish a Ministry for Seniors.

As there had already been very intensive discussions in the context of the individual agenda items, the discussion here focuses on the objective of drafting a paper against age discrimination, which is to be disseminated in all participating 17 countries and in the EU.
