

Projects Supporting eCollaboration of the Schools at All Levels

Working on the projects has important impact on promoting the cooperation and transfer of knowledge between schools (or other institutions) & people. With its projects, ISSBS as HE institution has established cooperation at schools at different levels (primary, secondary & tertiary education).

ICT plays important role in facilitating the cooperation between institutions and supports projects in all phases (preparation, delivery, exploitation). Further one will be explained what is the 'main' role of ICT in supporting the projects at ISSBS.

- 1) Preparation, ICT support to projects is mainly held through e-mails and skype meetings.
- 2) implementation of the project, ICT support can be as follows:
 - a) **COMUNICATION**: Management tools -Base camp, Skype meetings, E-mail, Doodle;
 - b) **DISSEMINATION**: Website, social media (Facebook, twitter), flyers and newsletter in e-format, e-applications for events/activities ...,
 - c) E-platforms; e-classrooms: as e-repository (eg. study materials, quizzes, videos); as a tool for on-line teaching (VOX ...)
- 3) Dissemination-exploitation- sustainability is covered with ICT support mainly as open access of different resources and materials, eg.: open access to e-classrooms/platforms with materials; website with materials available ...

Below are shortly presented ongoing projects at ISSBS (with focus on ICT support to projects)

- **JM Chair: EU HELM (EU integration; European HE area and labour market), implemented in 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/20.** Activities focus on implementation of 4 courses (delivery supported with e-classroom) and of research (on-line surveys).
- **JM project: €U-InFed (EU Integration and Financial Education), implemented in 2017/18.** Activities focus on implementation of seminars for pupils in primary & secondary schools and for HE students; seminars for teachers; conference for school leaders; final conference & research. Activities are supported with e-classrooms, e-simulations, on-line surveys ...
- **KA3 project: RoMigSc (Inclusion of Roma and Migrants in Schools: Trainings, Open Discussions and Youth Volunteering Activities), delivered in the period 2017-2019.** Activities are supported with e-classrooms; e-diaries & blogs; e-surveys ... in last year of the project will be developed e-platform where different (interactive) materials, videos, quizzes, interviews... will be available for teachers, volunteers and general users in 8 languages.
- **KA3 project: CiSoTra (Civil Society for social inclusion of unaccompanied minors in transition to adulthood – learning communities for shaping transition interfaces), delivered in the period 2018-2020).** Activities are supported with e-classroom, e-surveys, on-line delivery of trainings ...
