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Danube Region & e-Government

- Definition of e-Government:" The use of information and communication technologies in government to provide public services, improve managerial effectiveness and to promote democratic values; as well as regulatory framework that facilitates information intensive initiatives and fosters the knowledge society."
- Danube region is not homogenous, also in terms of e-Government application and experience.
- E-Government solutions and projects to improve cohesion and facilitate digitally remote countries to catch up.





Benefits of e-Government in Practice

Impacts on interaction mechanisms between:

- Citizens and state
- Private sector and state

=> To broaden public access to information ensuring transparency and government accountability.





Factors Impeding Use of ICT in Public Administration

- Unreadiness to perform public administration functions under conditions of information openness, accessibility and transparency;
- Lack of effective mechanisms promoting ICT introduction in all areas of social life;
- Lack of open dialogue between state, civil society and private sector.
- => **step-by-step implementation** of e-solutions and reform of admin. procedures

e-Government tools and activities not only technical issue, they are embedded in day-to-day life.

Political leadership and good governance necessary for successful implementation (democratization, political influence, involvement of citizens).





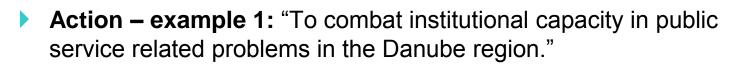
EU Strategy for the Danube Region Priority Area 10
